Please note: The VRC is following the guidance of public health officials as we open our health club facility to ensure we meet all needed protocols for sanitizing and social distancing. The pool is expected to open early to mid-July.

No Deposit Required: Stays dates now – May 31, 2021 will not require a deposit upon booking. Full payment will be due 7 days prior to arrival. At that time, the stay will be nonrefundable. Stays falling within the Holiday Season will require full payment November 1, 2020.

Waiving Change & Cancellation Fees: For a limited time, all new bookings made directly through the VRCMR will not incur a change or cancellation fee if made outside of 7 days prior to arrival or prior to November 1 for Holiday Season stays.

This offer is for stays now – May 2021. For any changed reservations, the arrival date will be honored for dates prior to May 31, 2021. Once within the 7-day period the stay will be nonrefundable.

These policies are for new reservations only and apply only to stays booked through the Vail Racquet Club website. These policies may change at any time without notice.

Special Provisions for Non-Local Residents visiting Eagle County

- 1. Any person that is not a Local Resident that travels to or visits Eagle County (a "non-Local Resident") must be free of any Symptoms consistent with COVID-19before arrival.
- 2. If any Symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are present in the 10 days prior to arrival in Eagle County, the non-Local Resident must not travel to Eagle County.
- 3. All non-Local Residents will self-screen for Symptoms each morning during their travel within Eagle County.
- 4. All non-Local Residents that develop Symptoms consistent with COVID-19 during their travel within Eagle County will:
 - a. Adhere to Self-Isolation requirements in Section (IV)(A)(1) above, even if this prolongs their stay in Eagle County at the traveler's expense.
 - b. Contact a local healthcare provider for guidance and to schedule7COVID-19 testing as quickly as possible.
- 5. All non-Local Residents that have been exposed to someone with Symptoms consistent with COVID-19 during their travel will:
 - a. Adhere to the Self-Quarantine requirements in Section (IV)(A)(2) above, even if this prolongs their stay in Eagle County and at the traveler's expense.
 - b. If Symptoms consistent with COVID-19 develop during the quarantine period, the traveler must follow the requirements outlined in Section (IV)(D)(4) above.
